



QUALITY ASSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Material ordered to Industrial, National or Federal Specifications shall be marked in accordance with the specific marking requirements contained in the applicable material specification.

Additional marking requirements are referenced in American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) A700, Packaging, Marking and Loading Methods for Steel Products for Shipment or ASTM B666, Identification Marking of Aluminum and Magnesium Products.

ASTM A700 gives standard guidelines for packaging, marking and loading of steel products for shipment and may include the following:

- (1) Manufacturer name or brand mark
- (2) Size
- (3) Specification (i.e., A36, A240, AMS 6414)
- (4) Grade (or type for stainless), Alloy (B209, B211)
- (5) Heat or Lot number (not required for C-1018)
- (6) Condition or Temper (A240, A479)

Any material received unmarked and/or untraceable to any material certifications that are requested will be process as nonconforming material.
